Reliable Networking – Hands on Workshop with bonus Simocode Lunch & Learn

Reliable networking is the concept of making the availability of networks meet or exceed the requirements of the application. For example, office networks, discrete industrial processes, and continuous industrial processes are real-world applications that all have different levels of required network availability. This 4-5 hour workshop based around the SCALANCE XC switch family explores the variability and criteria in different network application requirements, the strategies available to increase a networks reliability, best practices to mitigate network downtime, and troubleshooting techniques to quickly diagnose a network when a problem does occur.

This workshop is intended for customers who want to learn the methods and techniques to making their networks reliable and available. Primarily this might include automation network designers, controls and automation engineers, and maintenance personnel responsible for the automation network. Although it is lightly reviewed in the workshop, the attendee should have a fundamental knowledge of IP and MAC addressing and some networking exposure.
